Position :	Housing with Supports Team Lead
Reports To :	Executive Director
Job Summary :	The Housing with Supports Team Lead is responsible for overseeing and managing a team of professionals dedicated to implementing the Housing First approach within the Fort McMurray community. The role involves supervising team members, coordinating service delivery, ensuring program goals are met, and working collaboratively with community partners to address homelessness and housing instability.

Team Leadership	<p>Provide strong leadership to the Housing team, including caseworkers, outreach workers, and support staff.</p> <p>Develop and maintain a positive team culture focused on client-centered care and support.</p> <p>Conduct regular team meetings, training, and performance evaluations.</p>
Program Management	<p>Oversee the day-to-day operations of the Housing with Supports program, ensuring that services are delivered effectively and in accordance with program guidelines.</p> <p>Develop and maintain program policies, procedures, and quality assurance measures.</p> <p>Monitor and report on program outcomes and progress towards achieving housing stability for clients.</p>

Data Management	<p>Maintain accurate and confidential client records in compliance with privacy regulations. Prepare reports and data analysis to demonstrate program effectiveness and outcomes to funders and stakeholders.</p>
Resource Management	<p>Manage program budgets and resources efficiently. Assist in grant writing and fundraising efforts to secure funding for the program.</p>
